Marion County Utilities (“County”) hereby acknowledges Owner’s active Single Family Residence (“SFR”) building permit and request to install an interim conventional onsite sewage treatment and disposal system (“OSTDS”) within the ARPA Program Area. Owner’s conventional OSTDS installation is exclusively allowed due to County’s planned public sewer collection system (“System”) within five (5) years from the date of this notice, to provide wastewater service for a SFR on this parcel. Owner is aware by signing this Agreement they have officially applied for a utility sewer account for the SFR. The SFR shall be connected to the newly installed central wastewater collection system once the system has been certified for service. The County shall provide the on-lot connection once service is available. Please complete a Letter of Consent allowing our contractors to perform work on your property.

Previously requested Owner connections for SFR that have been (1) issued Final Inspection or Certificate of Occupancy, or (2) is an actively permitted parcel for SFR construction and has this completed and accepted notice on file with County shall entitle Owner to a no-charge connection to County’s sewer system and abandonment of the OSTDS and any and all other benefits identified and in accordance with the Board-approved Resolution for this Project Area. NOTE: This only applies to SFR in areas where the supporting Resolution, which identifies the specific service area, has not been approved by the Board of County Commissioners. Once the Resolution is approved, any active permitted parcel for SFR construction that has not obtained a final inspection will not be included in the no charge program.

Potable water service will also be available, and although not mandated, is highly encouraged to capture the same no-cost-to-Owner benefit. Requires a completed New Service Agreement to receive this benefit.
